Helping People Help Themselves

Casa de Amigos

The mission of Casa de Amigos is “to help people help themselves.” This is accomplished by offering services in four areas: adult education, health & wellness, youth education and social services.

Centers for Children and Families

Centers has helped strengthen individuals and families in West Texas since 1957. The agency was founded to provide counseling for those who otherwise would not be able to afford it. Centers also offers parenting programs, supervised visits and exchanges, and post adoption support.

Community Children's Clinic

Since 1983, the mission of CCC is to provide acute medical care for childhood illnesses and injuries for low income families without insurance. Services are available for children 7 months to 18 years.

Communities in Schools of the Permian Basin

Dedicates itself to keeping at-risk students in school. Whether it is addiction, grief, loneliness or homelessness, CISPB campus coordinators ensure students have a caring adult who will help them deal with these issues.

Family Promise of Midland

Family Promise of Midland helps the community coordinate their compassion to address the root causes of family homelessness. They provide shelter paired with extensive case management.

Provides leadership development experience for girls in grades K-12, fulfilling the Girl Scout mission of building girls of courage, confidence and character, who make the world a better place.

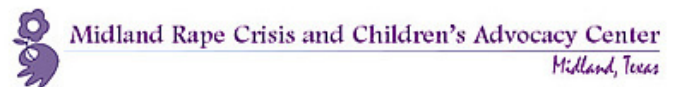
UWM funds the Girl Scout Leadership Development program.

Samaritan Counseling Center

Provides licensed, professional mental health counseling. The center's goal is to help restore hope and healing with mind, body and spirit for optimal health. Services are for people of all ages, individuals and families.

Senior Life Midland
